


Distribución de reservas probadas en el mundo: 1994, 2004 y 2014


- Middle East

Consumo Mundial de Energía




World primary energy consumption grew by a below-average 0.9% in 2014, the slowest rate of growth since 1998 other than the decline in the aftermath of the financial crisis. Growth was below average in all regions except North America and Africa. All fuels except nuclear grew at below-average rates. Oil remains the world's dominant fuel. Hydroelectric and other renewables in power generation both reached record shares of global primary energy consumption (6.8% and 2.5%, respectively).


Crecimiento de la demanda mundial de petróleo

Oferta Mundial de Petróleo

Informaciones de la OPEP indican que la oferta mundial de petróleo disminuyó en 0.34 mb/d para promediar 95.02 mb/d en diciembre del 2015, comparado con el mes anterior. La oferta de países NO-OPEP cayó en 0.13 mb/d y la de la OPEP en 0.21 mb/d. La participación de la OPEP en la oferta mundial alcanzó a 33.8% en diciembre de 2015.
